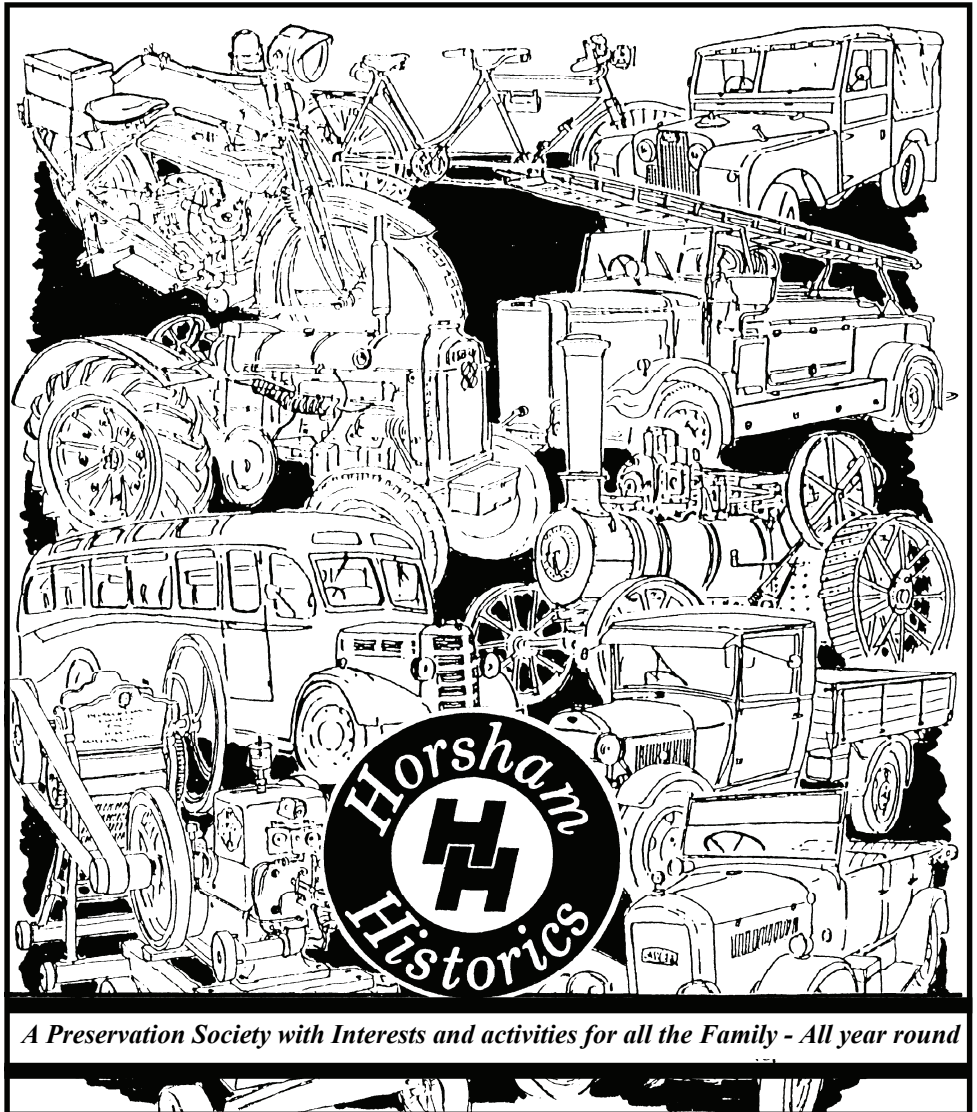

Horsham Historics Preservation Society was founded in October 1975 by a group of local enthusiasts who considered there was a need for a preservation society in the Horsham area of West Sussex.

If you are interested in Vintage Transport, Farming Equipment and machinery/ collections of all kinds (including Mills and other fixed equipment), you will find membership of ***Horsham Historics*** worthwhile.

Members receive a monthly Colour illustrated Newsletter giving reports on past events along with future activities in the area. Monthly winter meetings from September to April are held at Handcross Parish Hall where there is a very large car park. Meetings take the form of illustrated talks on subjects of historic interest and there is an annual Auction Night.

Summer evening meetings take us out and about to places of interest, treasure hunts or barbecue evenings. Full details of these meetings, and all our other forthcoming activities are published in our monthly Newsletter and website.

Other activities include an annual Winter Get-to-Gether on a Sunday in December when members bring along their vintage vehicles and machinery, models or bygone. ***Horsham Historics*** displays at other events around the area.

A modellers and car show are held at Newhaven fort in May. There are also other informal visits, which take place outside the monthly meetings.

Our main annual event is the Ardingly Vintage and Classic Vehicle Show held mid July at the South of England Showground, Ardingly which is organised jointly with the Morris Register.
